

## Death in Armenia: entry in the Swiss civil status register

Documents to submit
□ original death certificate (*)
☐ Swiss identity documents of the deceased (passport and identity card). The voided documents can be returned for commemorative purposes if the family requests this when submitting them.
□ contact information for reaching a member of the surviving family
The original documents are submitted to the civil status authority concerned in Switzerland and must not be older than six months. They will not be returned. Photocopies are not accepted. Additional documents may be required if necessary.
Legalisation / Translation / Apostille
All foreign civil status documents marked with (*) must be affixed with an apostille, translated into a Swiss national language and be notarized before being submitted to the Swiss representation.
Please bring one copy of complete set for the Embassy.
