The Ambassador's Residence at the Embassy of Switzerland in Armenia is seeking an individual for the position of Cook.

BASIC RESPONSIBILITIES OF POSITION

Responsible for the overall functioning and performance of the Residence Kitchen and for all food-related requirements of the Residence.

- Day-to-day planning and operation of the Residence Kitchen, to include preparation and presentation of food items, for the Ambassador and guests and for special events.
- Ensuring quality and health standards of food prepared to the highest possible levels.
- Proper utilization, accountability, and inventory tracking of raw materials and kitchen equipment.
- Ensuring proper storage of food items at all times.
- Preparing list of items to be purchased for the kitchen and shopping for food locally.
- Ensuring cleanliness in the kitchen area, including equipment, utensils, surrounding areas,
- Performing any other services and duties associated with the position and additional work in connection with kitchen operations.
- Overview the daily activities of the housekeeper of the residence
- Performing any other work as assigned by the Ambassador.
