BIOMETRIC SHENGEN VISAS

Visa information for Citizens of Burundi and Foreigners with valid legal work/resident permit in Burundi.

Effective from 6th June 2013 due to introduction of biometric visa process, citizens of **Burundi**, **holders** of officials or ordinary valid passports, going to Switzerland can apply for schengen visas of categories A and C only at the Embassy of Belgium in Bujumbura. All foreign visa applicants with legal work/resident permit in Burundi must appear <u>personally</u> at the Embassy of Switzerland in Nairobi for all "short stay" visas of categories A and C to submit their visa application. Embassy of Belgium in Bujumbura is not competent for examining their visa applications. Kindly make a visa appointment 4 weeks prior to the intended date of travel. See the email address below.

Short stay C visa (less than 3 months stay) for the purposes of private visits sponsored by friends or relatives, tourism, business, official travel, training, workshop, seminar, sports, ski trips.

Long stay D visa (more than 3 months stay) for the purposes of family reunion, study and work, all citizens of Burundi and Foreigners with legal work/resident permit in Burundi to submit their visa application personally through our Swiss Consulate in Bujumbura. As some exceptions apply (see the list below) for citizens of Burundi, we recommend submission of visa applications 4 weeks prior to the intended date of travel.

In representing Switzerland for the purpose of examining visa applications and issuing visas for short stays in the Schengen area (visa type A and C), the Belgium Embassy in Bujumbura will not be competent for citizens of Burundi and Foreigners for examining the following visa applications:

- Visa applications for short stays linked to a gainful activities.
- Visa applications for short stays linked to a study programme in Switzerland.
- Visa applications for short stays for medical purposes.
- Visa applications for short stays lodged by citizens of certain countries (check with the Embassy of Switzerland in Nairobi if you are not a citizen of Burundi)
- Visa applications lodged by holders of diplomatic, service or special passports who are not citizen of Burundi.

- Visa applications lodged by holders of an ordinary passport who intend to enter Switzerland on official purpose and who are not citizen of Burundi.

In the event of Embassy of Belgium in Bujumbura not being competent to examine an application, it will inform the applicant that he/she must submit personally the application to the Embassy of Switzerland in Nairobi after an appointment has been made in advance.

Kindly follow the various steps to ensure that the Embassy in Nairobi will receive a 100% fully completed applications with all the required enclosures based on the checklist requirements referring to the category and purpose of your trip.
