With the support of biocontrol and natural pollination the greenhouses managed to control the population of pests within acceptable quantities and protect plants from various diseases.
					The productivity of greenhouse in Darakert village increased by more than 25% and produced 28 tons of tomatoes from 1500sq.m. instead of 22 tons of the previous year, though usually greenhouses record at least 5% productivity loss every year of greenhouses exploitation. The second greenhouse in Voskevaz village is newly build and it is not possible to compare the productivity with the previous year yield, but was again 20% higher in comparison to the equal size and exploitation period greenhouse in the neighborhood. They had harvest of about 30 tons of tomatoes from 1300sq.m. which is significant number from such size greenhouse.
2	April-December 2011	Development of Traditional Handicraft (GEO)	Caucasian Institute of Social Strategies	13'665	Training centre was established within the frameworks of the project, where local population of Dedoplistskaro region (young girls and women, total 20 persons) was trained in picking up skills in old Georgian traditional handicraft. Participants learnt how to weave on the loom traditional Georgian saddle bags, bags, rugs as well as small souvenirs using old Georgian ornaments and natural colorants. The project managed to revive traditional weaving patterns and practice of using natural colorants, which had previously been almost lost. The project capacitated the participants with certain techniques and skills, which will be of use for them in future. Some of them have been employed by the training centre. Exhibition of the works was organized in December, which was a good chance for SDC visibility.

The exhibition included both paintings as well as various kinds of photography, video art, installations. The exhibition served as a platform for interdisciplinary discussion, where the problems of environment in the contemporary world were discussed by the young generation.
