

Travel Admin

The <u>TravelAdmin</u> allows you and your family to enter the dates of your holidays, visits, and business travels (short-term stays outside your host nation). Your Swiss guests/visitors can also register on TravelAdmin.

The FDFA will utilize your information to better locate and contact you if a serious crisis arises while you are

abroad. If the security situation in a specific region deteriorates unexpectedly, you will receive an alert.


Please note: TravelAdmin Online Registration is not an early warning system for natural catastrophes such as earthquakes, tsunamis, tornadoes, etc.

Follow the warnings and instructions of the local authorities in such situations.

On August 14, 1948, Indian Prime Minister Jawaharlal Nehru and Armin Däniker, Switzerland's first envoy to India, signed a friendship treaty between the two countries. This was the first treaty of this kind signed by independent India. The two countries are commemorating 75 years of this treaty through a biennial initiative that began in 2023.
