The 'Sustainable Civil Society Initiative' supported by the Climate Change and Development Division, Embassy of Switzerland in India is being implemented by Development Alternatives in the Bundelkhand region of Central India over the past three years. It addresses the needs of rural communities to enhance their capacities to cope with the changing climate while continuing on a path of economic growth. A growth path that also helps regulate their natural resource base on which their livelihoods depend upon. The project has developed and demonstrated practical methods, by which rural communities and local institutions can conduct their livelihoods which lead to better incomes, lower their carbon footprint and an overall reduction in climate vulnerability of the population.

This day long workshop is a forum to facilitate knowledge sharing to showcase activities initiated in the region under this project and find ways to scale up good practices in water management for food security.
