
National Summit – Energy Efficiency in Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs)

Synopsis: The Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) sector contributes significantly to India's economy. There are an estimated 26 million MSME units providing employment to 70 million persons and accounting for about 45% of India's industrial production and 40% of exports.

There are more than 400 manufacturing clusters across the country of which nearly half comprise energy intensive sectors like metallurgy ceramics, glass, textiles etc. In many of these energy intensive sectors, the adoption of energy efficient (EE) technology and best operating practices offer enormous potential for energy savings, reduction in CO₂ emissions as well as profitability enhancement.

MSMEs would seize any opportunity to adopt EE technologies, provided these are proven, cost-effective and supported by good technical back up and handholding.

Against this backdrop a first of its kind National Summit on Energy Efficiency in MSMEs is being organized under the aegis of Small and Medium Enterprises Energy Efficiency Knowledge Sharing "Sameeksha" a collaborative platform set up by The Energy and Resources Institute (TERI) in association with Bureau of Energy Efficiency (BEE) and Embassy of Switzerland in India and Ministry of MSME. The National Summit is also being supported by Agence Française de Développement (AfD), Energy Efficiency Services Limited

(EESL) and German Development Agency (GIZ).
