

Replacement of Lost/Stolen U.S. Social Security Card

Required documents

- Original valid **U.S. passport** of the applicant and U.S. citizen parent (if the applicant is a minor).
- Original or certified copy of either U.S. Birth Certificate, Naturalization Certificate or Consular Report of Birth Abroad
- Form SS-5 –FS "Application for a Social Security Card" www.ssa.gov/forms/ss-5fs.pdf

Replacement Card for Name Change:

- Valid **U.S. passport** listing the **new name** of the applicant and U.S. citizen parent (if the applicant is a minor).
- Documents showing reason for name change (Naturalization Certificate, court order, etc.)
- Form SS-5 –FS "Application for a Social Security Card" www.ssa.gov/forms/ss-5fs.pdf

Please read carefully:

The procedure is free of charge.

This office does not have the competence of filling out the required forms on your behalf and you need to complete them yourself.

You should <u>sign and date</u> complete forms during your presence at this office and not before. Signed forms cannot be accepted.

You need to submit your original U.S. passport with your file.

Only complete applications can be accepted for further process without any exceptions. Incomplete files will be refused and are subject to new appointment.

The personal presence of the applicant (s) is mandatory, minors have to be accompanied by at least one parent

Additional forms or documents may be required by the U.S. authorities depending on your case.
