

## Checklist for Schengen Visa - Diplomatic/Official passport holders

If you are holder of a Nepali Diplomatic/Official passport planning to visit Switzerland, Poland, Latvia, Slovakia, Belgium or Liechtenstein for official purpose you can apply for a short stay visa at the Embassy of Switzerland in Kathmandu.

## An appointment is required for submission of application.

## Online application form.

All applicants for a Schengen visa have to fill in the online Schengen visa application form through this link: <a href="https://www.swiss-visa.ch">https://www.swiss-visa.ch</a>. A printed hard copy of the form has to be submitted at the time of application.

**Important:** At the end of the online visa application process, please don't forget to download and print the form. **No copy of the form will be provided by email.** 

If for technical reasons the form is not downloadable, please keep your registration number safely and fill in manually the pdf form available here:

Submit the documents in the following order:

<ul> <li>Visa application form</li> <li>○ Duly completed and signed by the applicant</li> <li>In case of minors (under 18 years of age)</li> <li>○ Both parents must sign the application form and add a copy of their passports. If travelling unaccompanied or with only one parent/legal guardian, a letter of consent from the parents must be submitted. A birth certificate must be provided and minor identity card.</li> </ul>	
Two passport size pictures  o Not older than 6 months, 35-40mm in width, white background (for more details please refer to https://www.icao.int/Security/mrtd/Downloads/Technical%20Reports/Annex A-Photograph Guidelines.pdf)	
<ul> <li>Valid passport</li> <li>○ Issued within the last 10 years and with at least three months validity beyond the planned stay in the Schengen territory, with at least 2 blank pages</li> <li>○ Clear photocopy of personal data</li> <li>○ Copy of previous Schengen visas, valid US and UK visas, if any</li> </ul>	
Original Note verbale  o Issued by the Department of Consular Services, Ministry of Foreign Affairs (Nepal) mentioning the names of concerned persons, dates and purpose of travel  To whom it may concern letters will not be accepted as such	
Letter of invitation from the host organization  ○ A letter from the company/organization in Switzerland or the in the represented Schengen member state, detailing the purpose and duration of the visit.  This letter must be sent by the host organization directly to the Embassy by email to kathmandu.consular@eda.admin.ch	
Flight ticket reservation  o Booking of a round-trip airline ticket to Switzerland and back to Nepal. With names of all travellers

- The Embassy of Switzerland reserves the right to request additional documents
- Visa can be applied minimum 15 days and maximum 180 days before the planned stay, depending on the availability of the consular calendar
- No copies are made on your behalf and incomplete applications will not be accepted
