

Birth of a child in the Occupied Palestinian Territory: Entry in the Swiss civil status register

Documents to submit

□ Original birth certificate of your child in English (Shadhet Milad)

The original documents are submitted to the competent civil status authority in Switzerland and must **not be older than six months**. Documents will not be returned. Photocopies of civil status documents are not accepted. Additional documents may be required if necessary.

Please check the spelling of the names in English in order to avoid wrong registrations into the Swiss Register.

Translation

Documents, if issued in Arabic, must be translated into English by an authorized translator.

Legalisation

A birth certificate needs the get legalized by the Palestinian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Expatriates
