Certified extract of the Divorce Nisi issued by the court and respective English translation + 1 copy of both documents
Certified extract of the Divorce Decree absolute issued by the court and respective English translation, with the mention of when it entered into force + 1 copy of both documents
Document stipulating the parental custody of any joint children, unless indicated on the divorce decree or on the dissolution of registered partnership
Written change of address (if applicable)
2 copies of the passport

The Swiss representation in Colombo will forward the original documents to the competent civil status authority in Switzerland. Documents must not be older than six months (if they are older than six months please check with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs if they can still be certified/legalized).

The documents will not be returned. Photocopies are not accepted. Additional documents may be required if necessary.

Translation

Documents that are not in a Swiss national language must be translated into English.

Legalisation

All foreign civil status documents and the respective English translations must be legalised by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Sri Lanka before being submitted to the Swiss representation:
