Requirements with Authorization

One <u>national (type D) visa application form</u> duly filled in, dated and signed (must be identical as in passport) by the applicant. Applications which are not duly completed, dated and signed will not be accepted. Please also indicate your e-mail address and a contact phone number.	
Passport (Original and one photocopy_photo, personal data and signature page only) valid at least 12 months, issued within the last 10 years and with at least 2 blank pages	
ID Card or valid Resident permit (Original and one photocopy)	
Two recent passport photos (please consult the requirements on the <u>website</u>) recently taken, size 35mm x 45mm/1.38 x 1.77 inches, one must be glued on visa application form.	
One photocopy of authorization issued by Swiss authority	

Requirements without Authorization

Three <u>national (type D) visa application forms</u> duly filled in, dated and signed (must be identical as in passport) by the applicant. Applications which are not duly completed, dated and signed will not be accepted. Please also indicate your e-mail address and a contact phone number.	
Passport (Original and two photocopies_photo, personal data and signature page only) valid at least 12 months, issued within the last 10 years and with at least 2 blank pages	
ID Card or valid Resident permit (Original and two photocopies)	
Four recent passport photos (please consult the requirements on the <u>website</u>) recently taken, size 35mm x 45mm/1.38 x 1.77 inches, three must be glued on each visa application form	
Two photocopies of employment contract	

Please note that:

The Trade Office of Swiss Industries in Taipei reserves the right to ask for additional documents and/or for a personal interview. All documents must be in English or one of Swiss official languages.

The national Visa application fee amounts to EUR 80.- and is due in TWD cash. The fee will be charged upon your submission and is not refundable.

Processing your visa application takes 2-3 working days. If your visa has not been approved by your submission, the entire procedure may take 8 – 12 weeks.
