The visa application procedure is facilitated for spouses and registered partners of EU/EEA citizens. Spouses and registered partners of EU/EEA citizens can submit their application for a Schengen visa during the opening hours at the Regional Consular Center Bangkok without prior appointment. The appearance in person is required. The visa application cannot be submitted by courier.

Fees: The visa application is free of charge.

Further information: The submission of a travel and health insurance and of a flight reservation is not required. The passport can be picked up the next working day during the opening hours without prior appointment. The passport can also be returned to an address in Thailand by EMS if a self-addressed prepaid envelope (post stamp THB 50.00) is submitted. The Regional Consular Center Bangkok does not issue a visa to a citizen of a Schengen Member State who additionally holds the nationality of a third state.

Documents in Thai language must be translated into English or into one of the Swiss national languages (G, F, I) by a translation office.

If submitting documents to prove family relationships from countries other than Thailand, legalization from competent Embassy or Consulate is required.
