

# After your marriage performed in the Republic of Korea without the Swiss certificate of capacity to marry: entry in the Swiss civil status register

# Documents to submit

**Translation** 

After getting married in the Republic of Korea, the marriage needs to be registered in the Swiss civil status register (Infostar). In order to register the marriage, the following documents have to be submitted to the Embassy.

Submission of documents is possible with appointment or by post. Please contact the consular section of the Embassy by e-mail seoul.chancery@eda.admin.ch or by phone.

□ Valid passport in original							
□ 'Marriage Relation Certificate, detailed' (혼인관계증명서-상세) with Apostille* + copy							
☐ Certificate of residence: The Embassy of Switzerland in Seoul will issue a certificate of nationality and registration. The fee for the certificate is CHF 40.00 and has to be paid in cash in the local currency KRW.							
☐ Questionnaire for Marriage Registration: filled out and signed

☐ Valid passport in original (please make sure that your passport is signed)							
1) Birth Certificate							
□ Identification Certificate, <u>detailed</u> 'Gibon Jungmyungseo-sangsae (기본증명서-상세)' with Apostille* + copy							
□ Family Relation Certificate, <u>detailed</u> 'Gajokgwangye Jungmyungseo-sangsae (가족관계증명서- 상세)' with Apostille* + copy							
<b>Note:</b> Since December 2019, the Korean authority is issuing "English Language Certificate of Family Relation" (영문 가족관계증명서). This document is <u>not accepted</u> as it does not contain full information from the Korean version.							
2) Proof of your civil status							
□ Marriage Relation Certificate, detailed 'Honingwangye Jungmyungseo-sangsae (혼인관계증명서-상세)' with Apostille* +copy							
3) Proof of residence							
□ Registration Certificate 'Jumindeungnok Deungbon (주민등록등본)' with Apostille* + copy							
: only if you are residing in Korea; otherwise registration certificate of the residing country.							
The original documents are submitted to the civil status authority concerned in Switzerland and <b>must not be older than three months. They will not be returned.</b> Photocopies are not accepted. Additional documents may be required if necessary.
