IMPORTANT

- 1. Documents certified by a notary public will not be accepted.**
- 2. The documents must be certified by the issuing authority no more than 6 months before they are sent for registration.**
- 3. The documents submitted to the Swiss representation will not be returned. They will be translated, legalized and sent to Switzerland.**
