





Swiss Film: Songs Within

Film|Neu—Washington, DC's annual celebration of new German-language films from Germany, Austria, and Switzerland—is back! This year's festival will include screenings at the Goethe-Institut, the Austrian Cultural Forum, and the Embassy of Switzerland in Washington, DC. The films will be shown with English subtitles.

This year's Swiss production is *Songs Within*, in which Swiss director Katalin Gödrös brings Silvia Tschui's novel—a tale of relationships and emancipation set again the backdrop of 19th century Alpine Switzerland—to life. The story follows the musically-gifted maid, Elsie, who is forced into marriage with Jakob, a young farmhand. While Elsie yearns for a career as a musician, Jakob dreams of owning his own horse. Together, they must realize that their only escape from a future without prospects lies in joining forces. Register for the film <u>here</u>.



The Consulate General of Switzerland in San Francisco and the Heidiseum (home of the UNESCO Heidi Archive) invite artists, professionals, and aficionados from all backgrounds from the United States and Switzerland to showcase their unique interpretations of the Swiss icon Heidi. The beloved character from Johanna Spyri's classic novel has enchanted audiences worldwide since 1880, but in the age of Al and generative technologies, how would you reimagine Heidi? Experiment with various Al techniques, prompts, and software to bring new life to this piece of cultural heritage. After review by an international jury, winning artworks will receive a cash prize and be featured in an iconic exhibition in San Francisco alongside panel discussions exploring AI, art, and copyright.
