Notification to the Signatory and Acceding States to the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES), concluded in Washington on 3 March 1973

Acceptance of the amendment of Gaborone and reservations by the Czech Republic

On 5 August 2004, the Czech Republic deposited with the Swiss Government an instrument of acceptance of the amendment of article XXI of the CITES, adopted at Gaborone on 30 April 1983. The amendment of Gaborone has not entered into force yet.

On 5 August 2004, the Czech Republic entered, pursuant to Article XVI, paragraph 2, of the CITES, a reservation with respect to the following species listed in Appendix III of the Convention:

Fauna Mammalia Carnivora

Canidae Vulpes vulpes griffithi

Vulpes vulpes montana

Vulpes vulpes pusilla

Mustelidae Mustela altaica

Mustela erminea ferghanae

Mustela kathiah Mustela sibirica

Theses reservations became effective on the date of their deposit, i.e. on 5 August 2004.

The present notification is addressed to the Governments of the Signatory and Acceding States in conformity with article XXV, paragraph 2, of the CITES.
