Notification

to the Signatory-States and Members of the CONVENTION ON INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN ENDANGERED SPECIES OF WILD FAUNA AND FLORA

signed at Washington on 3 March 1973

In application of Article XXV, Paragraph 2, of the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora, concluded at Washington on 3 March 1973, the Federal Political Department has the honour to inform the Signatory-States and Members that instruments of ratification of the afore-mentioned Convention have been deposited with the Swiss Government by the following States:

Canada, on 10 April 1975, Mauritius, on 28 April 1975.

The instrument of ratification of Canada includes specific reservations based on Article XXIII of the Convention. They refer to certain species scheduled in its appendixes I and II. The texts of those reservations are attached to the present notification.

In accordance with Article XXII, Paragraph 2, the Convention will enter into force for Canada on 9 July 1975, and for Mauritius on 27 July 1975.
